

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- During Orchid Blooming's opening, Orchid tells her best friend Mandy that she wants to win an assignment to China. Why does she want to go there? What place holds a special personal connection for you?
- 2. Phoenix offers to help Orchid get the work experience she needs; what's his initial reason for helping her? How do his motivations change over time?
- 3. Orchid sets ground rules for their professional relationship, that they must keep to business, all business. When do you first sense that this will be hard for her to adhere to? How about Phoenix?
- 4. On the surface, Phoenix appears to have everything going for him, yet on the inside, he harbors insecurity. How does his feeling he can never live up to his dad drive his actions?
- 5. Orchid faced trauma in her childhood. Phoenix lost his father a year ago. How does their shared grief shape their relationship?
- 6. Phoenix and Orchid both strive to be good people, yet their struggles cause angst. Which parts of Phoenix and Orchid's experiences touch you? Which can you relate to? Do any remind you of personal experiences?
- 7. In the opening chapter, Orchid describes being multi-racial. "Beautiful, dark-haired Mom was the artist in the family, the woman who amused young Orchid with drawings of dogs in tutus, and cat soirees. When she was little, Orchid thought her Chinese half was connected to her creative side. Her analytical brain was from her dad's side, his long English ancestry stamped with stories of tradesmen and entrepreneurs." What are the varied or paradoxical ways that Orchid experiences being half Chinese?
- 8. Phoenix is an agency founder. Orchid is successful in the beauty industry. What do they have in common that draws them together? In your experience, how do shared professional interests develop into mutual respect?
- 9. What leads Phoenix to feel protective towards Orchid? How might his honorable intentions cause conflict for them later?

- 10. Which portions of Phoenix and Orchid's experiences or beliefs foreshadow difficulties that they'll experience later in their relationship?
- 11. How do both Phoenix and Orchid grow when the secret of how they met is revealed? Have you ever forgiven someone for keeping a secret?
- 12. At the beginning of the story, Orchid believes that going to China will bring her closer to her mother. By the end of the story, does she still need this trip to connect with her mom?
